

To go to Venice and the islands of Burano, Torcello and Murano.

From Punta Sabbioni, you can easily reach Venice and its islands using public transportation. The pier is located just over 700 meters from the campsite (on the right). You can walk there in about 10 minutes or use our **free shuttle bus service** which operates at the following times during this period:

08.45 – 9.15 – 9.45 – 10.15 – 10.45 for reaching the departing motorboats, and at 18.00 – 18.30 – 19.00 for the return trip.

The motorboats of line 14 to/from Venice operate every half an hour during the day.

The journey to Piazza San Marco takes approximately 35/40 minutes.

Departures from Punta Sabbioni take place from pier "B".

Please note: the last motorboat directly from Venice to Punta Sabbioni departs at 12:30 a.m. (this trip departs from pier "F"). If you miss it, you will have to reach Lido di Venezia using another line and then board line 14 towards Punta Sabbioni (at 02:16 a.m. - 03:16 a.m. - 04:16 a.m.). [\(complete schedule\)](#)

To reach the islands of **Burano**, **Torcello**, and **Murano**, there are connections almost every hour.

The motorboats depart from pier "A" and the line is 14 (only to Burano) or 12 (look for the sign Islands Burano, Murano, and Torcello).

Burano is the first island you encounter, and if you want to continue to Murano, you often need to change here. [\(complete schedule\)](#)

Between Burano and the nearby island of Torcello, there are connections every 15 minutes between 09:30 a.m. and 05:30 p.m. with line 9; before and after line 12, service is every 30 minutes. [\(complete schedule\)](#)

Tickets can be purchased in advance at our cash desk-reception (for cash), or at the pier before departure (they are the same).

A **one-way ticket costs 9.50** Euros and is valid for 75 minutes.

If you use other water buses or stay for more than a few days, WE SUGGEST YOU PURCHASE A "**FORFAIT**": there are tickets for 1-2-3-7 days, which give you the opportunity to travel on all lines (to/from Venice, within Venice – including the Grand Canal – to Burano, Murano, and Torcello, Chioggia... and, for the duration of their validity, for as many trips as you want). **Prices are:**

24 hours	Euro 25,00
48 hours	Euro 35,00
72 hours	Euro 45,00
7 Days	Euro 65,00

The validity of tickets starts when you pass them in front of the specific gray electronic reader located at the entrance of the pier (not on board!). *The ticket must be validated for each trip.*

Children up to 5 years old travel for free.

Dogs do not pay but must have a muzzle and leash.

Bicycles (for going to Lido di Venezia-Pellestrina-Chioggia or to S. Erasmo) require an extra ticket (purchasable at the pier). For some rides, transportation inside motorboats is at the discretion of the captain.
